17.01.03 Dr. T. Palaneeswari, The Chairman, gave an introductory note in which she presented the following:

- ❖ Genesis and milestones of SFRC
- ❖ B.Sc. Psychology has been inaugurated in the year 2022-23.
- ❖ SFRC has secured the 50th Rank across India in the Green Institutional Rankings.

- ❖ Examinr.io software is being utilized for the submission and evaluation of assignments and quizzes.
- ❖ A total of 165 faculty members and 100 among them have completed their doctoral degrees. There are 25 Ph.D Research Supervisors, and 65 faculty members have cleared NET/SET.
- ❖ Projects sponsored by UGC, CICT and TNSCST have been undertaken by staff members totalling an amount of Rs.25.1 lakh. 16 faculty members have been awarded Seed Money to the tune of Rs. 11,54,000/- by the Management for research projects.
- ❖ A student project was approved by SITARE-BIRAC-SRISTI-PMU and an amount of Rs.100000/- was sanctioned.
- ❖ A management grant of Rs.80,00,000/- has been sanctioned towards infrastructural additions and has been utilized for the installation of LCS in 10 classrooms, Solar Panels with a capacity of 84.4 kW, Water Dispensers, RFID Technology and 08 LED Projectors.
