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


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
### MINUTES ON ACTION TAKEN REPORT BY FEEDBACK COMMITTEE

Around 86% of the staff members have strongly agreed and 14% agreed that there exists a good balance between theory and practical in the syllabus. The success rate is achieved by periodical revision of the syllabus based upon the current trend.



Almost all the staff members have unanimously agreed that the contents of the courses are in conformity with the course outcomes and the system of Outcome Based Education absolutely helps the students learn more effectively.

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
Almost 68% of the staff members feel nominal number of students will achieve the assigned course outcomes after completing the course. The positive sign is achieved by introducing new curriculum with OBE. About 32% were agreed that the attainment level of COs, POs/PSOs and PEOs by the students is satisfactory. Also, 79% of the staff members have strongly agreed that they were able to incorporate the latest development and technology in curriculum. 20 % of the faculty have agreed they could cope-up with new curriculum. But 1% alone felt neutral with the latest development in curriculum.
