
#### STUDENTS' FEEDBACK - REPORT&ANALYSIS: 2020-2021

The Standard Fireworks Rajaratnam College for Women always aims to offer the best possible environment and learning experience for students to encourage them to perform to their fullest potential for academic achievement. Being a learning organisation, we have always engaged in the continuous process of obtaining feedback from different stakeholders in a more formal-informal manner. The feedback is collected online through the college website using separate individual login ids for each student and the reports on the responses from students are generated. During the Academic Year 2020-21, Feedback was collected from

Curriculum of the programme was well defined and promotes learning experience of the students






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

About 58% of the students have strongly agreed and 39 % of the students have agreed that the recent developments in the related streams are incorporated in the curriculum. Nearly 96 % of the students have strongly agreed that the Curriculum of the programme was well defined and promotes learning experience of the students through internship, student exchange and field visit. Industrial experts teach the students day-to-day applications of theoretical concepts taught to them.



About 54% and 42% of the students have "strongly agreed" and "agreed" that the curriculum fully focuses on employability skillset. Nearly 53% and 44% of the students have "strongly agreed" and "agreed" that the Programme carries sufficient number of optional papers. The Curriculum for each Programme offers sufficient number of Core Elective and Non-major Elective Courses. So, it helps them to explore with the basic concepts in the interdisciplinary subjects too.



Around 75% of the students responded in the positive manner that the Term test and Examinations are conducted well in time with proper coverage of all units in the syllabus regularly. This clearly suggests that the teachers are dedicatedly working together with students in all aspects. This shows the quality of the relationship between teacher and students.

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
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

## Teaching & Learning



About 96% of students responded in a more positive manner on the teaching and mentoring process which facilitates their cognitive, social & emotional growth. The high positive response had been achieved by arranging a faculty as mentor for each student to guide each and every student. Also, more skill based training programmes are conducted to improve the employability and entrepreneurial skills of the student.



About 91% of the students strongly agreed that the institution shows interest in promoting internship, student exchange and field visit. The success rate is achieved by conducting periodical field visit. Industrial experts are invited to handle special sessions on industry-oriented training for value addition. Internship programme was made mandatory for students. Staff and Student Exchange Programmes are conducted by entering into Memorandum of Understanding with the educational institutions.


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## MINUTES ON ACTION TAKEN REPORT BY FEEDBACK COMMITTEE

Nearly 97% of students are accepting that the institution monitors and review the improvement in the quality of the teaching learning process. We have a "teaching practice" — not a "teaching perfection." This little play on words emphasizes the central point that practice implies continuously working to get better. This shows the quality of the relationship between teacher and students. Periodical trouble shooting sessions are conducted with students to know what is working and what is not working.




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



About 88% of the students have responded in a positive manner for their feedback on the Assessment Pattern being followed in the institution.



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


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



About 97% of the students have responded in a positive manner that question paper pattern was strictly followed.



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


About 94% of the students have responded in a positive manner. Balancing students' workload is very important. So, workload is equally distributed across all the three Terms Tests.

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
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
