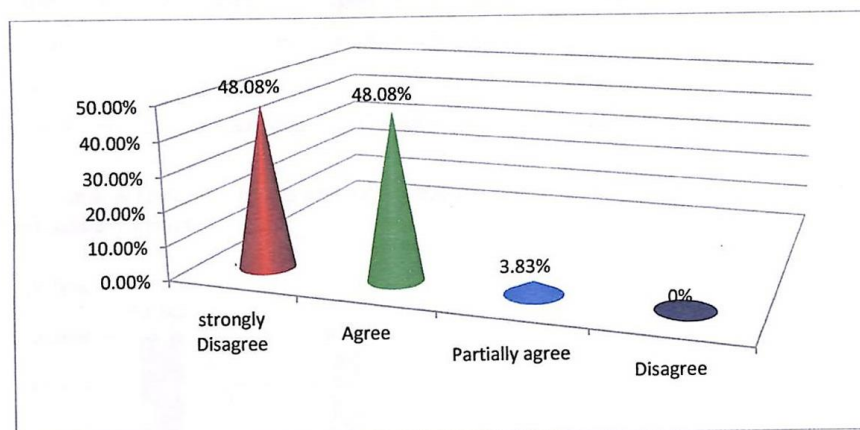

Feedback Analysis and Consolidation Report**

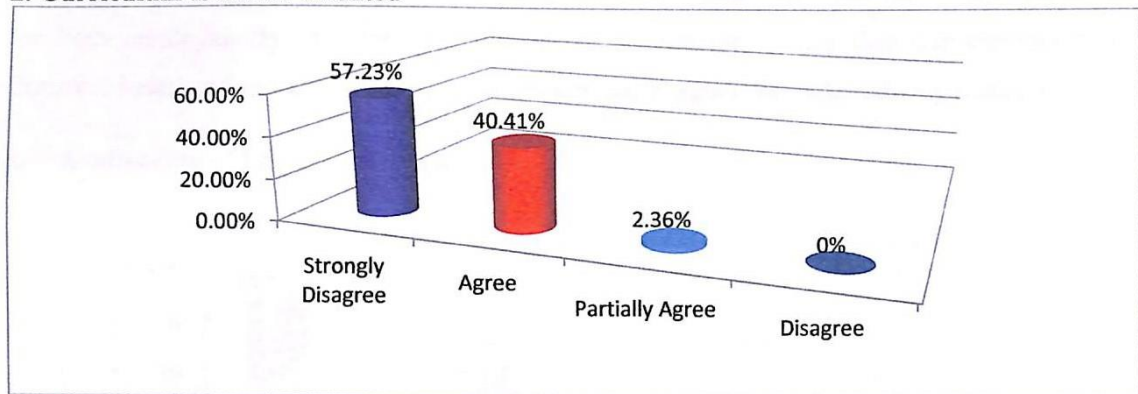

Totally 339 alumnae submitted their online feedback forms comprising 10 questions. The consolidated report of their opinion on the curriculum, outcome based education, competencies, skills and knowledge for the year 2022-23 is presented here.

**1. Communicative English helps to build better inter-relationship in the work place**



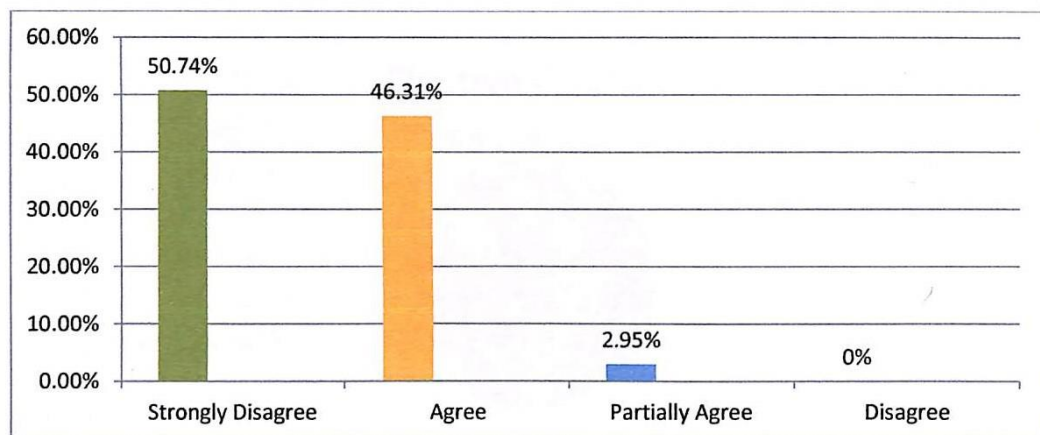

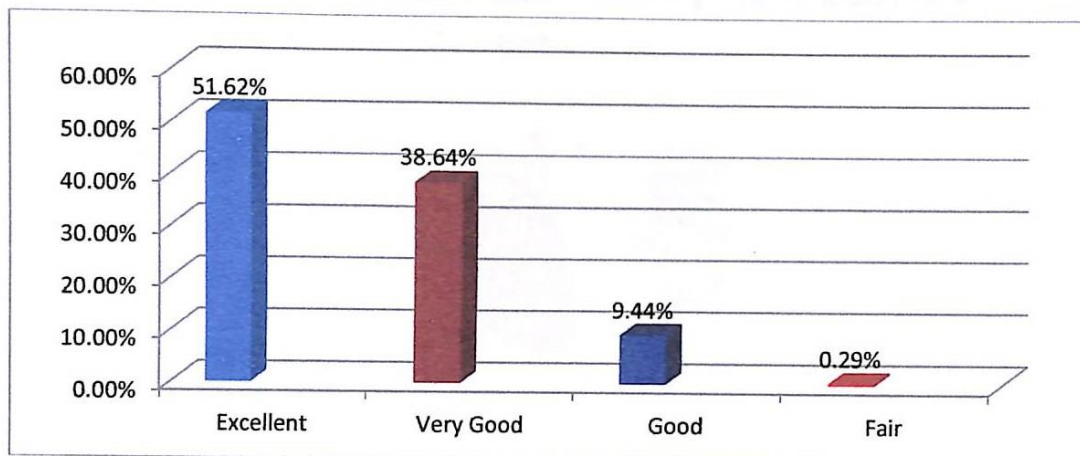
## 3. Curriculum is Outcome based and all expected Course Outcomes and Programme Outcomes are attained

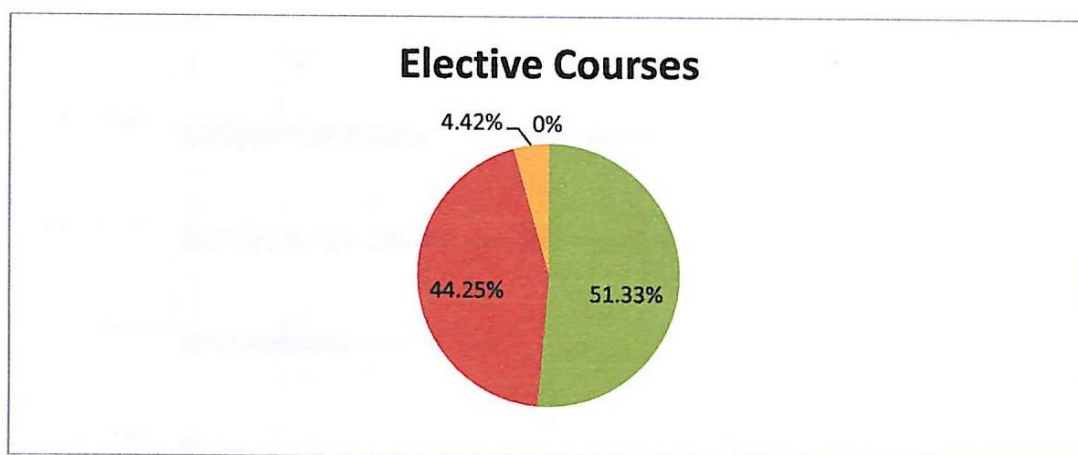

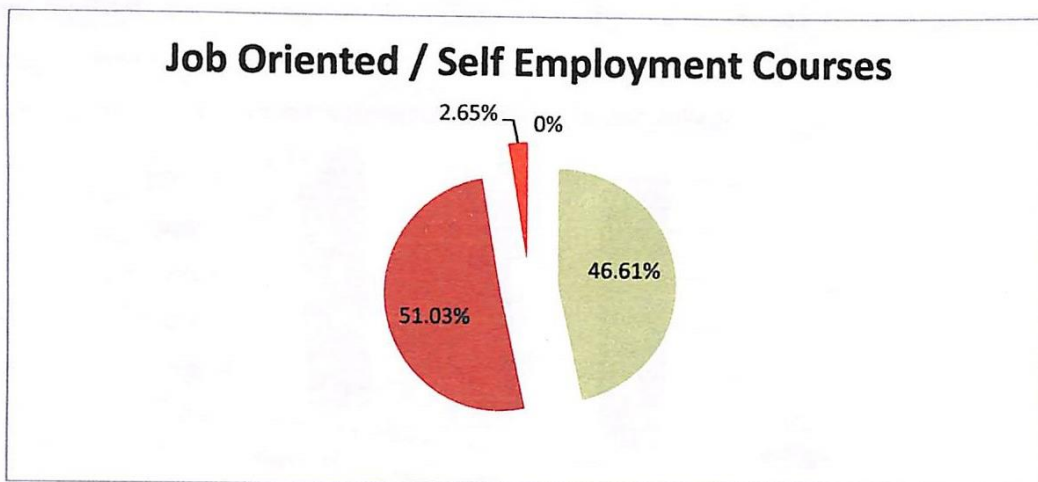
#### 5. Elective courses provide basic knowledge about other disciplines



Elective/Non Major Elective Courses are offered both in the PG and the UG Curricula. They provide opportunities for students to explore knowledge beyond their core discipline. It

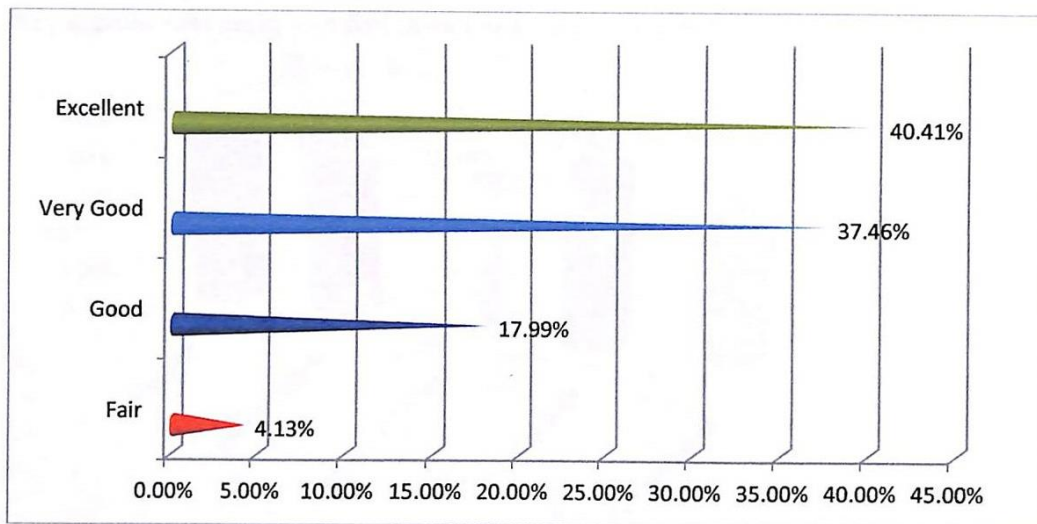
helps them to broaden their horizon. Our Alumnae feedback also emphasizes the usefulness of Elective Courses.

**7. Placement opportunities for the Students**



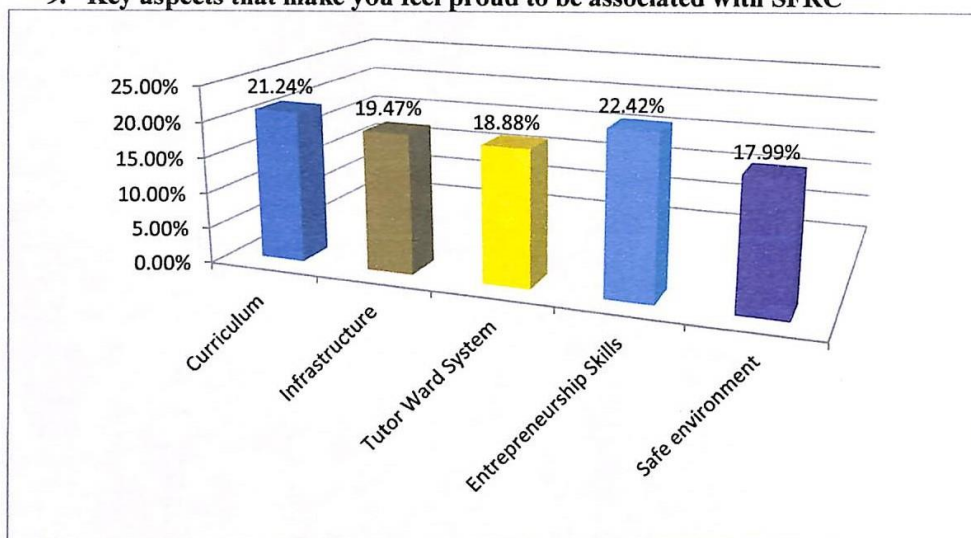

**8. Opinion on the current infrastructure facilities in our college**




**9. Key aspects that make you feel proud to be associated with SFRC**


