Feedback by Students on Curriculum: 2022-23 [ODD] – An Analysis

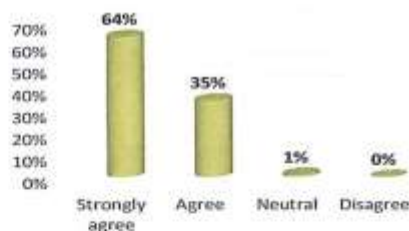

The Standard Fireworks Rajaratnam College for Women, Sivakasi is committed to the highest standards of education and other provision for its students, and encourages them to provide the Institute with thoughtful and constructive feedback. The feedback is collected online through the Students’ Portal and the statistical analysis of the responses is automatically generated. Feedback on curriculum was collected from 3068 students during the odd semester of the year 2022-23.

Knowledge based and career oriented

Course Content

Curriculum prepares the students with the knowledge to be successful and confident in their career. 64% of the students strongly agreed that the course content was knowledge based and career oriented and 35% of the students agreed the effectiveness of the course content in the curriculum.

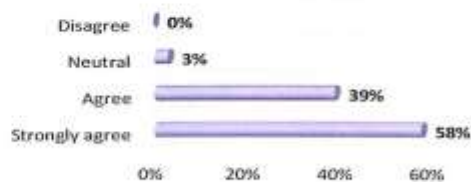
Course content was knowledge based and career oriented.

The Outcome Based Education aims to identify the strengths and weakness of students and equips them to be distinctive in their careers. Altogether 97% of the students opined that identification of strengths and weaknesses enables the accomplishment of the predetermined outcomes.

The Programme carries sufficient number of optional papers

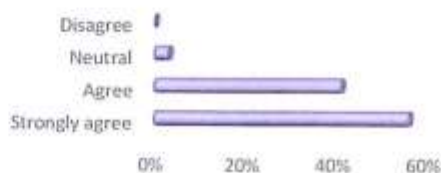
The Curriculum for each Programme is designed in such a way that it offers sufficient number of Major Elective and Non-major Elective Courses and 97% of students agreed the same.

The Outcomes of the Courses are Well Defined and Accomplishment Of Outcomes.

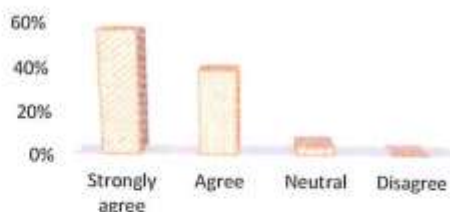

Depth of the course content is adequate in relation to the expected Course Outcomes.

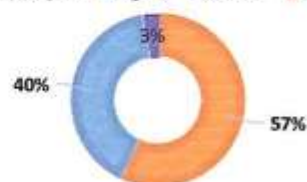


The Curriculum Enhances the Relevant Employability Skills.



The Programme Carries Sufficient Number of Optional Papers.

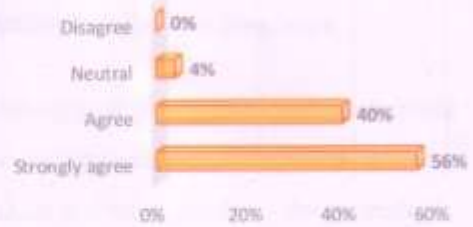

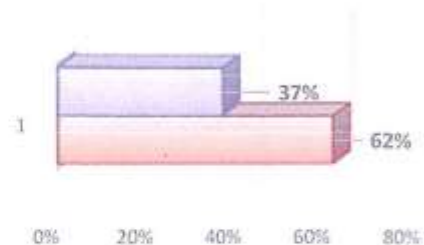
Well defined CO's& Accomplishment of outcomes

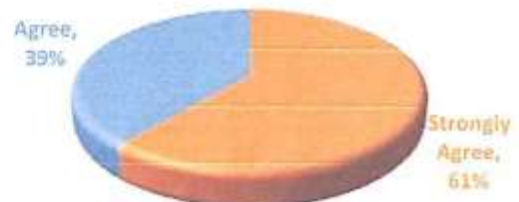
Depth of the course content is adequate

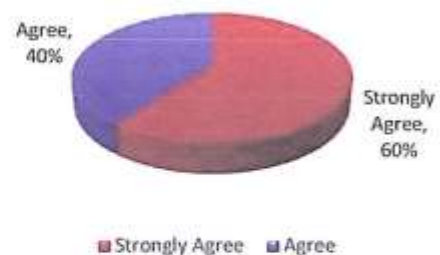

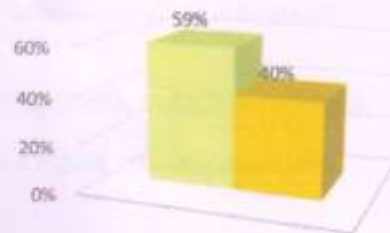

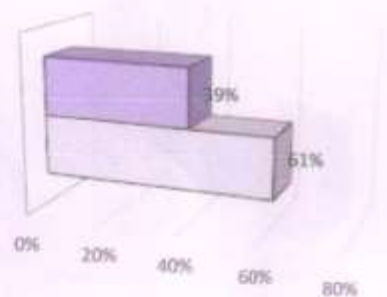
