Our Science Instrumentation Centres are sophisticated instruments like. **UV-Visible** Spectrophotometer, FT-IR equipped Spectrophotometer, Luminescence Spectrometer, DSC, TGA, GC-MS, AAS, HPLC, PGSTAT, Microwave Synthesizer and well-furnished class room with LCD projectors to ensure top-grade research culture. We have also organized many International and National Level Seminars, CSIR-NET workshops and Intercollegiate meets. As a Research Department, 5 research supervisors and 4 scholars actively engage in research activities relevant to the contemporary needs in the field of Chemistry.
