11.30 a.m.

- Two participants per team.
- Quiz covers General Knowledge, Current Affairs, Slogan, Logo, Advertisement, Connection and Personality.
- Duration: One hour.

E-Waste Goldmine (Don't Trash It, Cash It)

11.30 a.m.

- Two participants per team.
- All materials must be sourced exclusively from electronic waste.
- Participants are responsible for bringing their own E-waste materials.
- Duration: One hour.
- Judging Criteria: Creativity and Originality (30), Use of E-waste Materials (20).

Stride Squad (Corporate Walk)

11.30 a.m.

- Maximum Five participants per team.
- Costumes and outfits must be appropriate for a corporate setting and respectful of all cultures.
- Vulgarity is strictly prohibited.
- Props are permitted. But they must not cause any harm to the stage or participants. Use of fire, smoke, or other hazardous materials is strictly prohibited.
- Music must be submitted in a MP3 format. Teams must ensure its quality.
- Duration: 5 minutes. (Presentation: 3 minutes, Questions & Answers: 2 minutes)
- Judging Criteria: Adherence to Theme (15), Confidence and Attitude (15), Costume and Styling (10), Q&A (10)

Ground-Breaking Tunes (Imitation Dance)

01.30 P.m.

- Theme: Perform a dance imitating an original 80s song
- Maximum Six Participants per team.
- Duration: 4 minutes
- Songs must be decent and suitable for all audiences.
- Only one song is allowed per performance - mixing or combining multiple songs is not permitted.
- Costumes should match the original style, but stay modest and respectful.
- Song must be submitted in both MP3 and MP4 formats.
- Judging Criteria: Accuracy of Imitation (15), Style (10), Costume & Presentation(15), Similar expression (10).

Scroll Stoppers (Reels creation)

11.30 a.m.

- Theme: Professionals in Accounting
- Two participants per team. (1 Creator & 1 Editor)
- Anyone can appear in the reel, but only the Creator & Editor will be awarded.
- Reels must be original and unique—even if inspired by trends.
- Plagiarized content will lead to immediate disqualification.
- No offensive, vulgar, political, or inappropriate material.
- It must not violate the privacy or rights of any individual or community.
- Reels can be in English, Tamil or a combination.
- The reels must be created in a vertical format with a 9:16 aspect ratio.
- The maximum duration for reel is 90 seconds. Reels exceeding this limit will be disqualified.
- The visual and audio quality should be clear and of good resolution.
- A Reels video must be submitted at the time of registration.
- Judging Criteria: Creativity and Originality (20), Relevance to the Theme (20), Editing and Production Quality (10)

General Rules and Regulations

- Registration Fee: ₹200 per participant
- Refreshments and lunch will be arranged for all registered participants and accompanying staff.
- Each group must be accompanied by a designated staff member.
- A maximum of 15 students per team is permitted.
- Each student is allowed to take part in only one event. (Exception for those participating in Reels Creation)
- Open exclusively to undergraduate women students from Commerce stream.
- The completed registration form must be submitted via email or WhatsApp on or before 17th September 2025. A hard copy, duly signed by the HOD and Principal, must be submitted on the day of the event.
- Participation should be confirmed via online payment made by the Staff-in-charge (GPay: 9655340723 / 8754896905) on or before 25.09.2025. Kindly share a screenshot of the payment with the organizing secretaries as proof.
- Spot registration is not encouraged. Pre-registration through email or phone call is mandatory.
- All participants must carry a valid institutional ID card.
- Decisions made by the judging panel are final. No appeals or objections will be entertained.
- No TA/DA will be provided.
